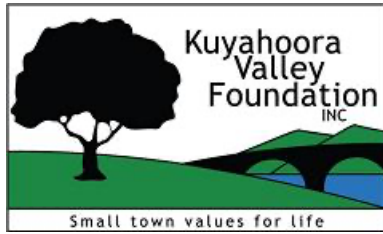


## 28<sup>th</sup> Annual MAC Daddy



Veterans Day – a day to recognize those who served in the past and those serving today. Memorial Day symbolizes a time to honor the US service men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice and gave their lives during military service. Over the last two+ decades, Memorial Day has also represented the Memorial Atlanta Classic (aka MAC Daddy) and the generosity of everyone associated with this event. The MAC Daddy, along with many other facets of our lives, has evolved since Covid and is now an event we cherish each Fall.

This year, 16 teams competed in the MAC Daddy tournament, and even more people contributed to a larger goal. Thanks to the generous contributions from golfers, donors, family and friends, we raised over **\$12,000** to support [Helping Mamas](#) and the [Kuyahoorra Valley Foundation, Inc. \(KVF\)](#)!

Helping Mamas is Georgia and Tennessee's leading baby supply bank, dedicated to bridging the gap between the community and families living in poverty. Helping Mamas provides essential baby and period products, ensuring dignity, health, and opportunity for those who need it most.

Since 1989, the Kuyahoorra Valley Foundation, Inc. has raised over \$830,000 to support philanthropic causes through charity golf tournaments and other events along with the new KVF Day of Service to support our communities across the country. The Kuyahoorra Valley Foundation, Inc. is a recognized 501(c)(3) non-profit organization (Tax ID #: 41-2091147) founded in the Kuyahoorra Valley of Central New York. Our objective is to demonstrate "Small Town Values for Life" by helping those in need on a local and national level.

\$10,000 (80%) of the funds raised from the MAC Daddy Golf Tournament benefitted Helping Mamas, and the remaining twenty percent benefitted the Kuyahoorra Valley Foundation, Inc., which supports people in need from small communities in Central New York and wherever they may extend, including the Metro Atlanta Area. This is a one hundred percent volunteer effort, and all the proceeds are used to help someone in need. A special thank you to our sponsors, donors and participants! The winning team of the 2025 MAC Daddy included Steve Cundill, Brandon Cundill, Joe Barleiri, Jayden Barleiri with a score of 135 (9-under par overall – a new MAC Daddy record!).
